

The scholarship can cover at least part of your expenses related to the thesis, typically related to data collection.

Requirements:

- Topics/research questions and/or empirical context must be of relevance for tourism.
- The application must include a project plan that includes information about WHAT (topic/research questions), WHY (background), HOW (theoretical perspectives, methodology and schedule for task completion) and budget.

- 3. Before financial support can be awarded, one must:
 - Document expenses with receipts and a short financial report
 - Make the data collected accessible to the research program for confidential storage and further academic use.
 - The final project is to be delivered as a pdf-file and may be published on the webpage of the research program. You must state in the preface of the project that you receive financial support from the Northern Insights research project.

Part of the financing $\underline{\text{may}}$ be paid before completion.

Students that are about to begin or are in the process of writing their bachelor- or master project can apply for the scholarship in tourism.

Different topics and theoretical perspectives can be used, however one must:

- study problems relevant for tourism, or do empirical work on general issues relevant for tourism (lodging, food, nature- and cultural based experiences, transportation etc).
- have a focus on the high north (wholly or partly)

Each scholarship can be up to NOK 10.000. A committee representing the host campuses awards the scholarships.

The scholarships are offered by the research program "NORTHERN inSIGHTS - Experiences in the High North". This program is managed by a consortium consisting of the following institutions: Bodø Graduate Schools of Business (HHB v/UiT), University of Tromsø (UiT), Harstad University College (HIH), Nordland Research Institute, NORUT Alta and Bioforsk. The program is financed through the Norwegian Research Council.

The research program consist of 15 sub-projects with topics related to production, innovation and learning, marketing, consumer behavior, value creation, destination development, organization and management within the context of service and experience-based tourism in the High North. Students can work with issues related to one or more of the sub-project topics or can develop their own research questions.
